- For the 2019/2020 academic year, we currently have fourteen mainstream and two ASD classes. Based upon our enrolment figures on September 30th, 2019, we will be losing a mainstream class teacher for the 2020/2021 academic year. This will result in some classes being split to cater for this adjustment in staffing levels next year.
- Our number one priority in Duleek GNS is to provide meaningful learning experiences for pupils of all abilities. Using digital technologies in an effective way can help achieve this goal. It was agreed that the school should purchase 25 chromebooks and a charging station to help facilitate these types of learning opportunities for pupils.
